

# RECYCLING REGULATION

Framework legislation, establishes requirements for:

- Recovery Rate
- Stakeholder Consultation
- Funding
- Access
- Performance Measurement
- Dispute Resolution



## PPP

- Packaging & Paper Product and Beverage Containers
- Residential and 'streetscape'
- Compostable packaging

# NEGOTIATION

- Right of first refusal
- Staff, vehicles and infrastructure
- Free from contracts for hauling
- Free from contracts for processing and marketing



# INDUSTRY PRIORITIES

- Level-playing field
- Fees vs Cost
- Contamination (non-PPP)
- Performance (compliance)

# POST-COLLECTION

- Processing separated from collection
- Risk/Reward for materials rests with processors and producers


## DECISION POINT



- Data: households, collection types and costs
- Collection and education
  - Accept
  - Decline (direct service)
  - Opt-Out
- Multi-Family

# IMPLEMENTATION

- Same contract for all collectors
  - Master Services Agreement and Statements of Work
- ‘Negotiation’ period
- Deadline for signed agreement
