Plastic Bags Reduction Act

- The Plastic Bags Reduction Act came into effect on October 30, 2020.
- Provide an opportunity to limit at source
- Compliance with the Plastic Bags Reduction Act appears to be very favorable
- Reductions in litter (Trashformers data)
- Tracking data to evaluate any potential for unintended consequences





Littering fines

- Under the Environment Act, Inspectors can
 - issue litter-control orders to require the person responsible to clean-up any litter deposited contrary to the Environment Act
 - can issue summary offence tickets for \$467.50 for an out-of-court settlement or court prosecutions can result in court orders to clean up and fines of up to \$100,000.



Mandate Letter – Litterbug Act

▶ Enact legislation (*Litterbug Act*) establishing the highest provincial penalties for littering and embark on an advertising campaign to inform Nova Scotians.

Expanding EPR in NS

Current EPR programs:

 paint, used oil/filters, electronics

EPR for PPP:

 includes materials commonly found in NS' blue bag system Many PPP items are reported in litter audits/clean ups

As part of ECC engagement, staff are asking input on whether litter objectives should be incorporated in a proposed EPR for PPP program

















Education/promotion

- Annual program funding:
 - Adopt-A-Highway and Great Nova Scotia Pick Me Up programs, which assist volunteer groups and individuals completing community litter clean-ups.
 - Education a theme throughout:
 - Part of the compliance continuum
 - Element of the bag ban (why ban was implemented)
 - ▶ EPR for PPP producers can use education as a means for reducing litter
