

SUPPLY REPORTS ARE NOW OPEN

Supply reports for the calendar year 2023 are now available in Divert NS' EPR Portal. The reports must be submitted by October 1, 2024. The following resources are available on Divert NS' website to assist you in completing your supply report:

In the EPR Portal, you can find the 2023 supply report under the "My Supply Reports" tab. If you delegated supply reporting to the PRO, the reports are under the "My PRO Reports" tab.

Producers are required to enter data in the five categories of designated material supplied into Nova Scotia, upload a brand list and provide a signed attestation of the information provided.

When entering a supply report, producers need to confirm they are an obligated producer for the reporting year. If a producer falls within any of the small producer exemption criteria, no supply data will be required for that particular year.
