

A First Step: Eliminating Single-Use Plastic Grocery Bags



Goodbye plastic bags




In July 2019, we announced that we would be eliminating single-use plastic bags across our store network, starting with our Sobeys locations.

The commitment would take 225 million single-use plastic bags out of circulation annually from our 255 Sobeys stores – that's enough to wrap around the earth twice!

We gave ourselves six months to make the change at our Sobeys stores, until Jan 2020. With our other banners, IGA, Safeway, Foodland and others to follow.

Employees are your greatest advocates

Inform customers often and start the conversation well in advance

Provide cost-effective options for the transition

Plastic Parking Lot – Sobeys Timberlea, Nova Scotia



Opened a new Sobeys Store in Timberlea, Nova Scotia on November 28.

In partnership with Crombie REIT, we diverted the equivalent of more than 6 million postconsumer plastic bags by using recycled plastic in the asphalt in the parking lot.

Public Seating on the Waterfront

In October 2019, Sobeys unveiled the 'Ultimate Picnic Bench' on the Halifax waterfront in partnership with LakeCity Plastics and Develop Nova Scotia

The table was made using GoodWood Plastic's plastic lumber (lumber made using recycled single-use plastic bags).

Sobeys is donating 61 benches for installation on shorelines across the Atlantic region

The initiative will divert 720,000 plastic bags from landfills


